PBM Regulations by State

National and State Level Regulatory Requirements Specific to Pharmacy Benefit Management

State: Connecticut

Applicable Rule(s)

Conn. Gen. Stat. § 38a-479bbb establishes the formal statutory registration and regulatory oversight standards for Pharmacy Benefit Managers operating in the State of Connecticut. Under this statutory rule, a corporation, business, or other entity may not act as a PBM or administer the prescription drug portion of a health benefit plan on behalf of a plan sponsor in Connecticut without first applying for and obtaining a certificate of registration issued by the Connecticut Insurance Department (CID). The Connecticut Insurance Department confirms that PBM registration is mandatory.

Compliance Statement

The Pharmacy Benefit Manager maintains the required Connecticut Pharmacy Benefit Manager certificate of registration pursuant to the statutory mandates of Conn. Gen. Stat. § 38a-479bbb. The Pharmacy Benefit Manager maintains verifiable records supporting its active Connecticut PBM status and monitors state-level statutory updates.
