PBM Regulations by State

National and State Level Regulatory Requirements Specific to Pharmacy Benefit Management

State: Florida

Applicable Rule(s)

Florida Statute 626.8805

Establishes the requirements for pharmacy benefit managers (PBMs) to obtain and maintain a Certificate of Authority (COA) issued by the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation (OIR) prior to conducting PBM activities in Florida. The requirements include application submission, regulatory review, and continued compliance with applicable PBM licensing and operational requirements.

Florida requires pharmacy benefit managers operating within the state to maintain an active Certificate of Authority issued by the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation and comply with applicable PBM regulatory requirements, including licensing, registration, and oversight obligations.
