PBM Regulations by State

National and State Level Regulatory Requirements Specific to Pharmacy Benefit Management

State: Florida

Applicable Rule(s)

Florida Statute 626.8828

Requires that all contractual arrangements between a pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) and a pharmacy benefits plan or program executed, amended, adjusted, or renewed on or after July 1, 2023, for pharmacy benefits provided on or after January 1, 2024, include, in substantial form, contractual terms that ensure compliance with the statutory transparency and accountability requirements. Compliance with these contractual requirements is subject to examination by the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation pursuant to F.S. 626.8828.

Compliance Statement

Contract Addendum

A Florida statutory addendum has been completed and incorporated into applicable pharmacy benefit management agreements to satisfy the contractual requirements of F.S. 626.8825(2). These terms are incorporated into the applicable agreement. The addendum includes the required provisions to ensure compliance with Florida's PBM contract requirements, and the organization maintains the documentation necessary to demonstrate compliance during examinations conducted by the Florida Office of Insurance Regulation under F.S. 626.8828.
