National and State Level Regulatory Requirements Specific to Pharmacy Benefit Management

Applicable Rule(s)

O.C.G.A. § 33-64-2 establishes licensing and regulatory requirements for Pharmacy Benefit Managers operating in the State of Georgia. The statute requires a person, business entity, or other entity acting as or holding itself out to be a PBM in Georgia to maintain a license issued by the Georgia Commissioner of Insurance, with the license subject to annual renewal.

Compliance Statement

Pharmacy Benefit Manager Licensing and Continued Compliance

The Pharmacy Benefit Manager maintains the required Georgia Pharmacy Benefit Manager license pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 33-64-2 and maintains the license through the applicable annual renewal process. The organization maintains the financial requirements and maintains policies and procedures designed to ensure continued compliance with Georgia PBM licensing and operational requirements.
