Applicable Rule(s)

Title 23 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations (NYCRR), Part 500 establishes cybersecurity requirements for entities regulated by the New York State Department of Financial Services (DFS), including the implementation and maintenance of a cybersecurity program, cybersecurity policies, risk assessments, security controls, incident response procedures, and the annual filing of a Cybersecurity Certification of Compliance or other required filing with the DFS.

Cybersecurity Requirements and Continued Maintenance

The Pharmacy Benefit Manager maintains a cybersecurity program designed to comply with the requirements of 23 NYCRR Part 500. The organization has completed and maintains compliance with the annual Cybersecurity Certification of Compliance filing requirement with the New York State Department of Financial Services and continues to maintain applicable cybersecurity policies, risk assessments, security controls, incident response procedures, workforce training, and other safeguards required under 23 NYCRR Part 500.
